THE PROGRAM Entity Aftercare Service is a voluntary, outreach program for young people who have left Care and want more support as they learn to live independently.

Each young person is allocated a Case Manager, who assists them to develop a case plan and achieve their personal goals. Goals are set by the young person and may include such things as accessing their leaving care plan, housing, education, employment, health, legal issues, family relationships, financial management, recreational activities, living skills and access to services. The Case Manager is also there to support the young person through times of crisis.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE All young people who have been in Out of Home Care and have previously accessed other services provided by Caretaker's Cottage INC (such as Entity Residential Unit, Horizon Semi Independent Service, Caretaker's Cottage Refuge and Options Youth Housing) are eligible. Referrals are accepted by the young person or current case worker.
